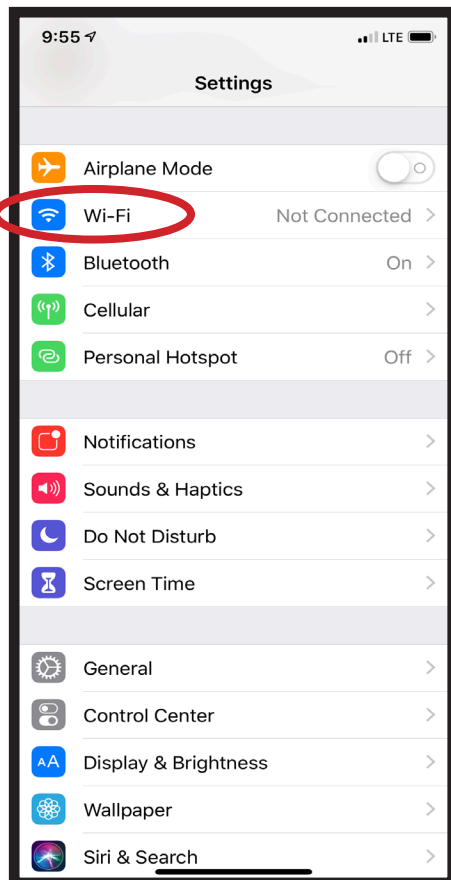
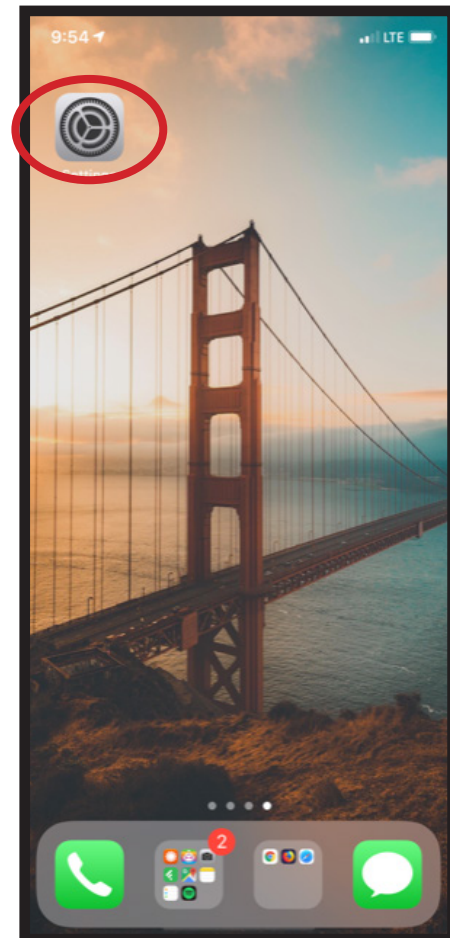

Connecting your iOS Device to the eduroam Wireless Network

1. To configure your **iOS Device** to connect to eduroam, select the **Settings** app.

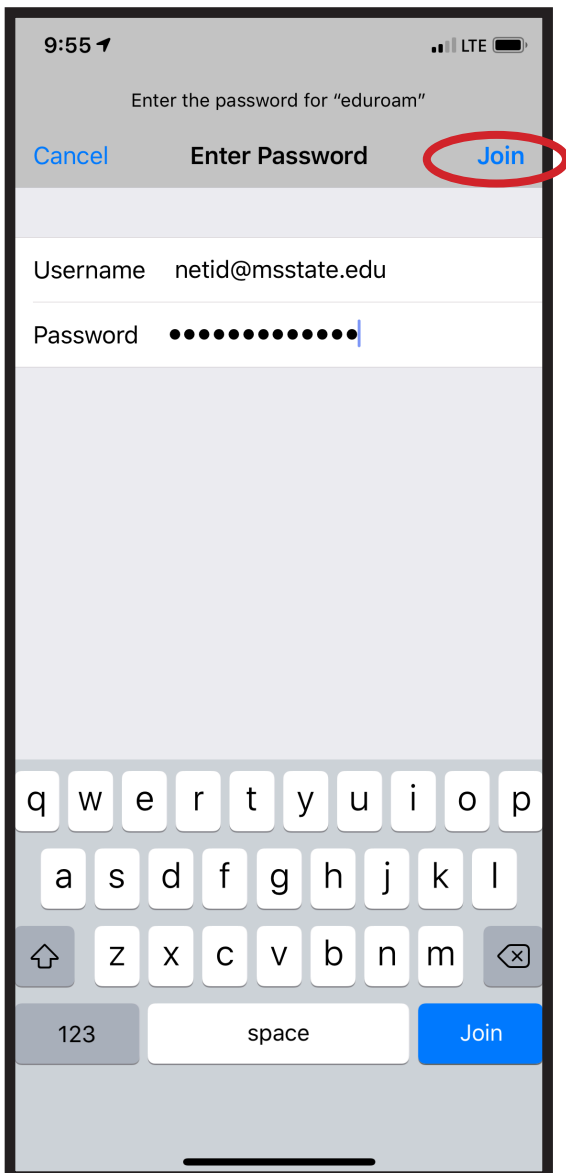
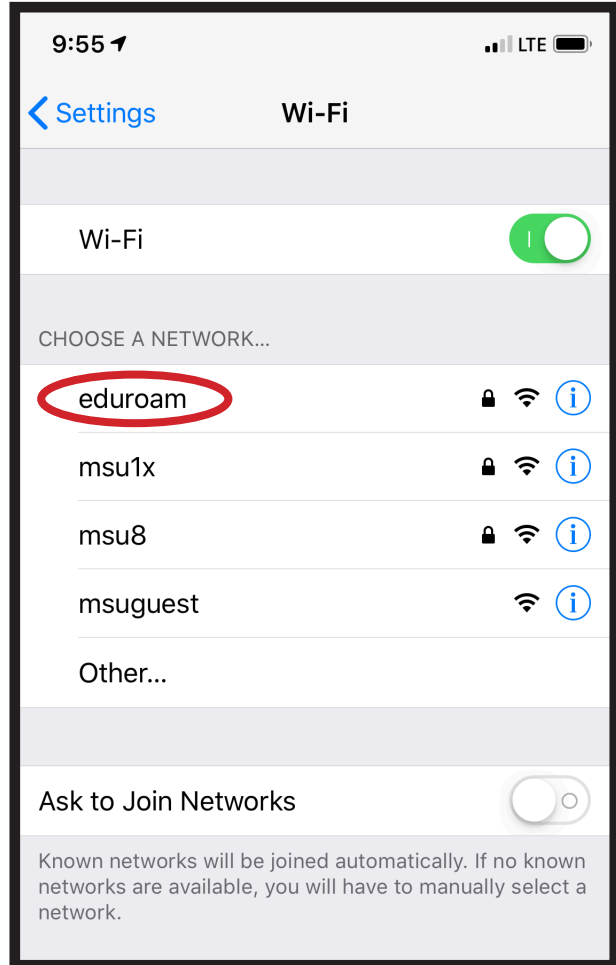


2. Touch the **Wi-Fi** icon to see the list of wireless networks near you.



3. In the **Wi-Fi Networks** screen, choose **eduroam**.

If a network other than **eduroam** has a check-mark next to it, tap the blue round button to the right of the network name and tap **Forget this Network**. This will allow you to connect to eduroam.



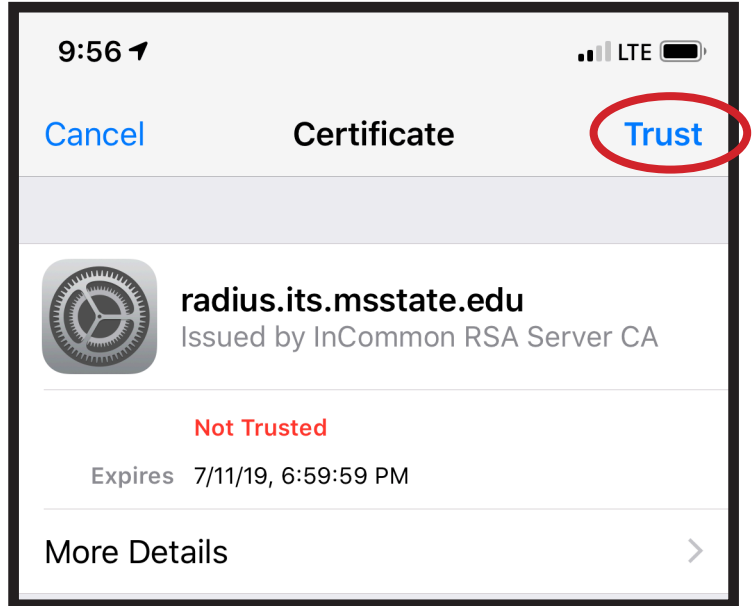
4. With **eduroam** selected, you will be prompted to enter your **Username** (*netid@msstate.edu*) and **Password** (*NetPassword*). Tap the **Join** button after completing these fields.

NOTE: *The Join button will be highlighted in blue after the information is filled in.)*



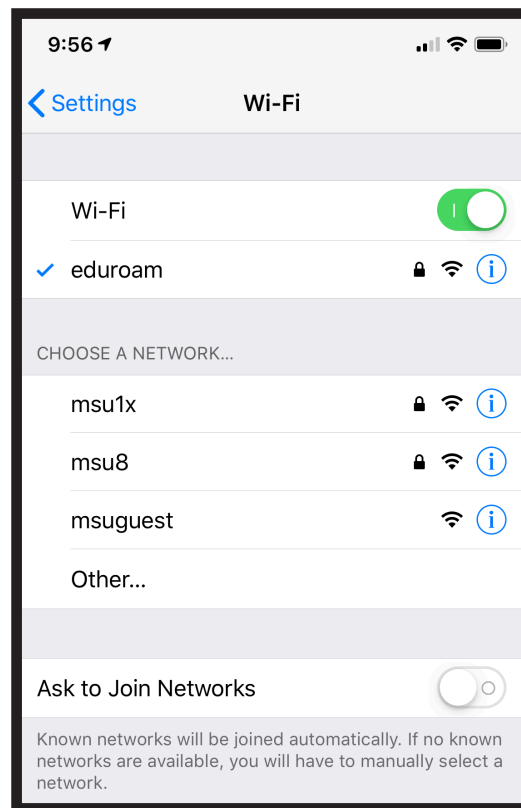
5. The **Certificate** screen appears. Tap **Trust** to connect to the **eduroam wireless network**.

After the initial configuration, you will automatically connect to the eduroam wireless network when detected. This is a one time only configuration. (unless you have to forget the network for any reason)



6. The **eduroam** wireless will be acquired and will connect automatically after set up.

If you are at an institution that also has **eduroam**, you will connect to their **eduroam** wireless.
